## Using Projector and Amplifier in the Commons Areas

Located in the cupboards of each commons area (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> grade commons and Team Time Room) are all the cables and peripherals you need to hook your laptop up to the projector and amplify your volume to near deafening levels!

- 1. **For just video**, turn on the projector and plug your laptop into the wall mount using the vga cable with the blue ends.
- 2. For video and background (soft) audio, turn on the projector and plug your laptop into the wall mount using the vga cable with the blue ends and the 3.5 mm audio cable (this one has green ends).
- 3. For video and loud audio, turn on the projector and plug your laptop into the wall mount using the vga cable with the blue ends. Turn on the amplifier (mounted above the projector) using the remote in the cupboard and plug the 3.5 mm audio cable (this one has green ends) from your laptop to the auxiliary audio input on the side of the white microphone on the lanyard...make sure you also turn on the microphone by pushing the power button on the top.
- 4. For just a loud microphone (or a loud microphone on top of your projected image), turn on the amplifier using the remote from the cupboard and the microphone on the lanyard. Then you can just hang the microphone around your neck and walk around. This can be very useful for quiet students!!
- 5. Please return the cables, microphone, and amplifier remote to the cupboard when you are finished.
